CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Competitor's age will be taken as that on the day of the competition.
- The adjudicator's decision is final.
- The competition committee reserves the right to combine, spilt, or delete Classes according to entries.
- Trophies will be awarded in all categories except primary Classes, competitors must be in dancing costumes to receive awards.
- Cups and Trophies must be returned for next year's Festival. The trophy holder is responsible for the safe keeping of the trophy which is the property of HIMDF.
- Dancers must fill in for reels as requested. Dancers from the first four may be asked to fill in.
- Protests must be in writing, signed and presented to the Chairman on the day of the pertinent competition.
- All dancers must register at the registration point prior to the start of their competition and show a current S.O.B.H.D registration card. Any dancer who does not have a card must report to the organiser before the events.
- In the Highland Dancing Competition, first to enter will be last to dance.
- If you have not received your competitor number within ten days of posting, please contact 07510 841198 for confirmation that your entry has been received. Phone calls for non receipt of number after the **15th March 2010** will not be accepted. NO LATE ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED.
- If a Beginner, Novice or Intermediate dancer changes sections before the dancing competition on Saturday, 1st May 2010 they must phone 07510 841198 and notify change by Wednesday, 28th April 2010.
- Confined to Argyll and the Western Isles Classes will dance at the same time as the main Premier competition therefore dancers who are eligible to dance in the confined section by residency (historic boundaries of Argyll apply) must choose which of the two Classes available they wish to dance in.
